Opportunity for Small Business

The New Payments Platform presents a significant opportunity for small businesses across the Australian economy. The Platform's combination of faster funds availability and enriched data capability could drive considerable efficiency improvements, as well as improve customer service and lower costs.

The New Payments Platform could enable:

- Immediate funds availability in less than a minute
- Faster payments from customers, 24x7, with no cut off times
- Richer payment data with up to 280 characters available, compared to only 18 previously
- Simpler addressing with customers able to make payments to a business' PayID
- Streamlined invoicing processes with ability to combine invoice data with a payment request
- Enhanced payment reconciliation and operational efficiencies
- Opportunity to leverage the "Request to Pay" service enabling real-time payment requests from customers

The New Payments Platform uses the ISO 20022 message schema, which is the global standard for electronic data interchange between financial institutions. This ISO messaging can be used to enhance current capabilities and processes, driving greater automation and operational efficiencies for businesses.
